LEAD BASED PAINT TENANT NOTIFICATION POLICY

Background: The Lead Based Paint Poisoning and Prevention Act (LBPPPA) of 1970 requires that all residents be notified of the possible hazards of lead-based paint poisoning and the precautions that can be taken to minimize lead-based paint poisoning.

According to Federal regulations, the property must have record of a Lead Based Paint Test if the property was constructed prior to 1978, is non-elderly, and currently falls under **any** of the following four categories:

- 1. Covered by HUD mortgage insurance; or
- 2. HUD-held (including 202 Loans and Purchase Money Mortgages); or
- 3. Covered by a contract for Housing Assistance Payments (Section 8).
- 4. USDA-RD (Rural Housing) 515 mortgages.

For ALL other property types built <u>before</u> 1978, testing is recommended, but <u>never</u> required. However, form RA-19 "Disclosure of Information on Lead-Based Paint Hazards" is required to be completed and placed in the resident files.

For *elderly* properties built *before* 1978, neither a Lead Based Paint Test nor form RA-19 is required.

For ALL properties built <u>after</u> 1978, testing is <u>never required</u>.

Managers will be responsible to provide all current households and all move-ins with a copy of the notification brochure to inform residents of required information. The brochure is titled "*Protect your Family from Lead in your Home*."

In addition, the head of household, spouse and co-head will be required to sign and date form RA-19, "Disclosure of Information on Lead-Based Paint Hazards." The original RA-19 will be kept with the lease attachments in the resident file. A copy of the form should be given to all lease signers, as well.

Please refer to the attached "Lead Based Paint Property Disclosure Listing" to determine whether these requirements are applicable to your property or if your property is exempt. IF the property is **exempt** neither the RA-19 nor the "Protect your Family from Lead in your Home" brochure need to be given to the residents.
